## ***EZ Fill Hummingbird Feeders***

### **Filling Your Feeder**

1. Opus has several options for hummingbird nectar: Ready-To-Use, Concentrate and Powder. All three products were formulated to simulate the nectar found in nature. Simply follow the directions with each package to prepare nectar. Refrigerate the unused solution.
2. Make sure all nectar is removed from base. Turn feeder upside-down and sit on counter. Unscrew the plug from the funnel base. (Figure 1) Pour in nectar to fill bottle. (Figure 2) Replace plug and securely tighten. Turn feeder upright. Hang and enjoy your hummingbirds.

### **Hanging Your Feeder**

1. To attract hummingbirds throughout the growing season, we recommend planting early and late blooming flowers. Recommended flowers include Fuchsia, Gladiola, Hollyhock, Trumpet Creeper, Bee Balm, Petunia and other trumpet flowers.
2. An S-Hook is provided to make hanging easier.

### **Cleaning Your Feeder**

1. We recommend cleaning your feeder twice a week, especially in warm weather. Hand wash the feeder with warm water, mild soap and a soft sponge.

***Important Note: Assembling base unit: Orient the raised tabs on underside of base top to align with notches on the top of the cylinder on the bottom half of base unit.***

### **Special Note**

Direct sunlight may cause pressure to build up inside the nectar container, forcing nectar out the feeding ports. If you notice nectar seeping out, move the feeder into a shaded or semi-shaded location.
